Mission/Vision trip - I am eagerly working on putting together a trip in Europe in order to accomplish 3 things: 1) Give our students an opportunity to see how God is at work in a post Christian culture. Learn from churches and ministry leaders about how to navigate that context. 2) Hopefully awaken a sense of global mission through their vocation. We have a lot of future bankers, engineers, lawyers, etc. I would love for them to ask the question, "What would it look like to use my gifts in this foreign place (as a banker) rather than go to Dallas or NYC?" 3) Be immersed in Church History. We have a very eclectic group at Texas RUF. Each Wednesday our LG is full of Roman Catholics, Greek Orthodox, run of the mill big church evangelicals, Presbyterians, atheists, and so on. There is both sneed and a growing desire from our students to learn about the rootedness of our tradition and the reasonableness of our faith, particularly with young men. Please pray that I would hear back from those churches and ministries (City to City) so we can start the final planning.

Please pray for a possible mentorship that may be forming with a student who runs a significant ministry on campus. The Senior Longhorn started running a ministry called Revive a number of years ago. For example, the first chaplain in SAE in many years, the Vice President and Educator (imagine the mother hen of all incoming freshman) for Kappa, the president of Theta, the president of BYX and Spurs, and the president of all of Panhellenic who will welcome 1,000 freshman girls next week for rush. Most of these girls have helped write a devotional for students who are going through the rush process. In other words, very "cool" students will have significant influence in their position and their names will be connected to Jesus as well as RUF. It leaves me asking, what is He up to?
